Dear Resident:

We would like to inform you that the Village of East Dundee has scheduled maintenance for the portion of roadway in front of your residence. The following streets are on this year's program:

- **Third Street** from Barrington Ave. to Railroad St.
 - The work performed on Third Street will include removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter, adjustment and replacement of manholes, patching the existing pavement, asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings, and restoration of the areas affected by construction.
 - **Note:** Once construction is started and the curb and gutter is removed, driveways will be inaccessible. Residents will be able to park on other streets in the surrounding area during this time, and the police department will be informed not to ticket any parked vehicles during this period. Please contact us at 1-847-426-4535 if you have any concerns or accessibility issues.

- **Van Buren Street** from Barrington Ave. to 300 feet south of Edwards Ave.
 - The work performed on Van Buren Street will include removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter, addition of new curb and gutter, adjustment and replacement of manholes, patching the existing pavement, asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings, and restoration of the areas affected by construction.
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- **Barrington Avenue** from 40 feet west of the bike path to 100 feet west of Van Buren Street.
 - The work performed on Barrington Ave. will include removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter, adjustment and replacement of manholes, patching the existing pavement, asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings, and restoration of the areas affected by construction.
 - **Note:** Once construction is started and the curb and gutter is removed, driveways will be inaccessible. Residents will be able to park on other streets in the surrounding area during this time, and the police department will be informed not to ticket any parked vehicles during this period. Please contact us at 1-847-426-4535 if you have any concerns or accessibility issues.

- **South River St.** from Main Street to Elgin Avenue.
 - The work performed on South River Street will include the removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter on the east side of the road, adjustment and replacement of manholes, asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings, and restoration of the areas affected by construction.
 - **Note:** Once construction is started and the curb and gutter is removed, driveways will be inaccessible. Residents will be able to park on other streets in the surrounding area during this time, and the police department will be informed not to ticket any parked vehicles during this period. Please contact us at 1-847-426-4535 if you have any concerns or accessibility issues.

- **Kimberly Street** from Park Street to Deerpath Road.
 - The work performed on Kimberly Street will include removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter, adjustment and replacement of manholes, patching the existing pavement, asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings, and restoration of the areas affected by construction.
 - **Note:** Once construction is started and the curb and gutter is removed, driveways will be inaccessible. Residents will be able to park on other streets in the surrounding area during this time, and the police department will be informed not to ticket any parked vehicles during this period. Please contact us at 1-847-426-4535 if you have any concerns or accessibility issues.

- **Howard Avenue** from Madison Street to 125 feet north of Reese Ave.
 - The work performed on Howard Ave. will include removal and replacement of existing curb and gutter, adjustment and replacement of manholes, patching the existing pavement, asphalt surfacing, new pavement markings, and restoration of the areas affected by construction.
 - **Note:** Once construction is started and the curb and gutter is removed, driveways will be inaccessible. Residents will be able to park on other streets in the surrounding area during this time, and the police department will be informed not to ticket any parked vehicles during this period. Please contact us at 1-847-426-4535 if you have any concerns or accessibility issues.


- **Railroad Street** from Water Street to the creek.
 - The work performed on Railroad Street will include a surface course grinding and hot mix asphalt overlay.
 - **Note:** The operations on Railroad Avenue should have minimal effect on residents during construction. All driveways will remain accessible, and at least one lane of traffic will remain open.

- **Ravine Road** from 30 feet south of Oak Ridge Road to the Village Limits.
 - The work performed on Ravine Road will include a hot mix asphalt overlay.
 - **Note:** The operations on Ravine Road should have minimal effect on residents during construction. All driveways will remain accessible, and at least one lane of traffic will remain open.

The street program has been awarded to Chicagoland Paving of Lake Zurich, Illinois. Contractors must be pre-qualified through the state to be allowed to bid on this year's project. Due to the ongoing union strike we do not have a construction start date at this time. All maintenance should be completed by this fall, pending union negotiations and weather permitting. Once we hear from the contractor on the start date, the Village will be posting the information on their website, www.eastdundee.net, and also on the downtown electric sign.
