

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 10 - 19**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, ADMINISTRATION,  
CHAPTER 31, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES,  
SECTION 31.01, TELEPHONE SERVICES FOR ELECTED  
OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that **Title III, Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees, Section 31.01, Telephone Services For Elected Officials** be amended.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One.** That **Title III, Administration, Chapter 31, Officers and Employees, Section 31.01, Telephone Services For Elected Officials**, of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read:

**' 31.01 TELEPHONE SERVICES FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS.**

Each elected officer of the village may be provided a telephone allowance for the use of a telephone for village business. The telephone allowance shall be based upon the charges for a private, single party line without accessories. The telephone allowance shall be paid quarterly, at the time of the regular salary payments. The telephone allowance will be reimbursed as an expense, provided sufficient proof is provided to comply with Internal Revenue Service regulations. If an elected officer does not submit an expense reimbursement, for a specific quarter, no reimbursement shall be made. Nothing in this Section should be construed to prevent any elected officer or

official from electing to forego the telephone allowance provided for in this Section, or any part thereof.

**Section Two. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**Section Three. Repeal.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section Four. Publication.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

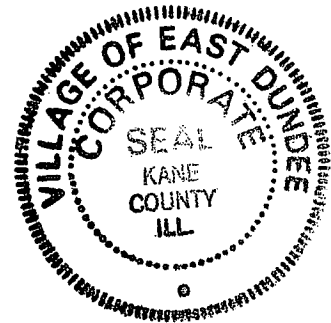
