Bicycle Registration Bring your bicycle to the Police Department Monday–Friday between 9am and 4pm. There is no charge.

Building Permits A building permit is required for all construction such as room additions, fences, basements, garages, re-roofing, siding, sheds, signs, satellite dishes, etc. If you have any questions call the Building Official at the Village Hall.

Children Fingerprinting The Police Department will fingerprint your children for identification purposes. Stop by during regular business hours.

Garbage & Recycling Trash & recycling pick up is on Wednesday of each week. The exception to this rule is the six major holidays observed by Flood Brothers. During the week of the below holidays, if the holiday falls on or before our regularly scheduled collection day, the collection day for that week will be Thursday:

New Year's Day	Memorial Day
Fourth of July	Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day	Christmas Day

These are the ONLY holidays that effect garbage pick-up. Garbage and recyclable items should NOT be placed on the tree bank any earlier than 6 pm on Tuesday, and must be taken back in no later than 6 pm on Wednesday. This will add greatly to the appearance and attractiveness of our Village. A 65 gallon recycling and garbage toter was issued to your address and should be used. Please contact Flood Brothers at (630) 261-0578 if you wish to receive a smaller container at no charge or need a 95 gallon container for an additional \$2 monthly charge.

Yard Waste Free yard waste pick-up is available to residents beginning the first Wednesday in April and ending the last Wednesday in November. Yard waste must be put into 35-gallon container or biodegradable paper bag. Brush and tree branches are to be securely bound in bundles not exceeding four (4) feet in length and two (2) feet in diameter.

White Goods Items such as stoves, refrigerators, etc. will be picked up at no charge. Please call Flood Brothers to schedule a pick-up, 630-261-0578. Please state that you are an East Dundee resident.

Electronic Recycling is provided to East Dundee residents at no charge. Residents can drop old TV's, computers, printers, scanners, VCR's, etc. at 448 Elgin Ave from 7am-2:30pm, Monday-Friday.

Parking Village ordinance states that no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am on any street within the Village. The reason for this is to help in police protection throughout the village and for the removal of snow. Also, no commercial vehicle of one-ton capacity is allowed to be parked in any residential district in the Village.

Smoke Detectors Functioning smoke detectors are mandatory as July 1, 1988 in all single and multifamily dwellings per State law.

Solicitors & Peddlers Need to show proof of registrations with the Village. "No Solicitors Invited" signs are available at the Village Hall. Hours of solicitation are 9 am to 9 pm Monday through Friday, 9 am to 6 pm on Saturday. There is to be No solicitation on Sundays and Holidays.

Testing of Local Sirens The first Tuesday of the month at 10:00 am. During threatening

weather you may hear a steady wail and means a tornado has been sighted in the area-take cover. NO all clear will be sounded. You will learn of the threat's cancellation from the National Weather Service by listening to a local radio station. A few radio stations in our area are WABT 103.9 FM, WRMN 1410 AM and WJKL 94 FM.

Vacation Watch Available while residents are away from their homes for extended periods of time. To request a vacation watch, please call or stop by the Police Department.

Water & Sewer Service The Village provides water and sewer. Water meters are read and billed every two months. Bills may be paid by mail, dropping off your payment during business hours, dropping off the payment in the night drop, sign up for Direct Pay, also online at www.eastdundee.net under E-Pay.

V. Important Village Ordinances

Alarm Ordinance: All false/accidental alarms responded to after four (4) in one calendar year will be billed at \$25.00 per call. This ordinance affects business and residential.

Junk Car Ordinance: Any motor vehicle, which is inoperable and does not bear a current state license plate, will be considered a public nuisance and its owner will be subject to a fine whether parked on public or private property.

Open Burning: Yard waste burning is only allowed on the second and fourth Saturdays during the months of October, November and April and the second and fourth Sundays during the months of October, November and April. Open burning under this section shall be allowed between the hours of 10:00am and 6:00pm October and November. Burning waste during other months could result in a complaint being filed. Small campfires, however, are allowed year round.

Sign Regulations: The location and size are restricted within the Village. Contact the Building Department before erecting any type of signage. Garage sale signs do not require a permit, but may not be placed on any public right-of-way.

Weed ordinance: Obnoxious plants, grasses and weeds cannot exceed six (6) inches in height. If this occurs, you will be notified by the Police Department.
